However, it is critical that the surgeon be aware that the CO pneumoperitoneum, far more so than laparotomy, results in multiple physiologic alterations that, if not compensated for by the anesthesiologist and surgeon, may endanger the patient or prevent the laparoscopic completion of the procedure.
